MEMBERSHIP CLASSES

PREAMBLE

- A These Rules are made under clause 7.1(d)(i) of the Adelaide Football Club's Constitution. They prescribe a new class of Membership and clarify the rules relating to the existing class.
- B Words and phrases defined in the Constitution have the same meanings in these Rules unless the context requires otherwise.

ORDINARY MEMBERS

There is to be a new class of Members to be called "Ordinary Members". Ordinary Members are those Members whose Membership benefits as prescribed by the Board do not include access to three or more home and away matches in a season. Ordinary Members have no right to attend or vote at General Meetings or to vote on elections of Directors.

ELECTING MEMBERS

The existing class of Electing Members (which excludes Ordinary Members) may be divided into various categories with differing benefits as the Board prescribes from time to time.
