The Engagement Journey

Following the signing of a Memorandum of Agreement with the City of West Torrens, the Adelaide Football Club has identified a **four-stage community engagement plan** where we will gather technical information, input from the public, and test the Master Plan against the expectations of the community. This process will then inform a final Master Plan for further consultation which will be undertaken by Council.

With Stage 1 (pre-engagement) tasks now complete, we have created a **draft Master Plan** which incorporates the technical requirements identified during this stage.
